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Use these discussion questions in your classroom to engage more deeply with this story.

FAIRY DOOR DIARIES

- Eliza learns that each fairy has a flower, and each flower has a fairy. If you were a fairy, which plant would you choose to live in?
- What plant does Eliza wear in order to see the fairies? How does she wear it? When she wants to visit the fairies, what does she have to do with it?
- Eliza is scared of the witches Wolfsbane and Belladonna, but she chooses to be brave anyway in order to rescue the fairies. Has there been a time when you felt scared but had to find a way to be brave? How did you do it?
- Why do you think Wolfsbane and Belladonna might want to take away the scents of the fairies and their flowers? What makes them different from Witch Hazel, who uses her magic for kindness instead of evil?
- When Eliza returns from the Land of the Fairies, her diary is filled with drawings and pages about her adventure. Try writing your own story about discovering a magical new world!
