
Seven Lille Ducklings

Seven Little Ducklings

- Take the class on a nature walk and ask them to count all the animals they see along their way.
- Show the illustrations to the students and ask them to point out all the animals in the background that are not part of the main storyline.
- Have the students create their own version of this story using simple illustrations.
- Discuss how the mother duck accepted other animals as her babies. Ask the students to share their thoughts on what makes a family.
- Provide cutouts of different animals to the students and ask them to group the ones that they think make a family.
