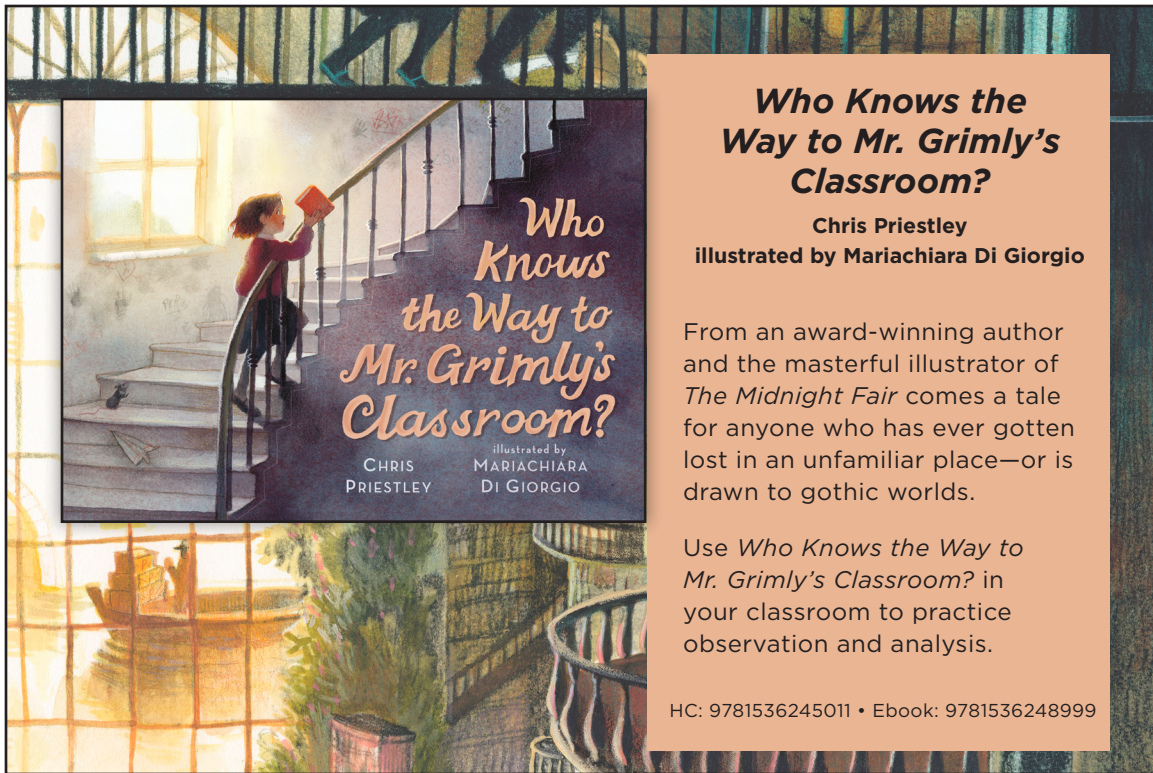




Who Knows the Way to Mr. Grimly's Classroom?

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Who Knows the Way to Mr. Grimly's Classroom?

- **Practice Observation:** This book is full of visual riddles and secrets hidden within the illustrations. Read the book aloud to your students and show the pictures. Ask students to point out things that they find strange in the images. How do the illustrations help to build an atmosphere of suspense?
- **Discuss:** After reading the book, define “genre” for your students, and list different genre types on the board, for example, fiction, nonfiction, mystery, romance, fantasy, horror, and thriller/suspense. What genre do you think this book is? How do you know? What is your favorite genre?
- **Art Activity:** Do you know the way around your school? Pass out drawing paper and have each student make a map. Compare maps.



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
